Characters: Four (either gender)

Tone: Serious

Synopsis: Designed as a reader's theatre piece, this refers to Elijah's experience at Mt. Horeb when he heard God's voice in a way he hadn't expected.

Running Time: Two minutes or less

Set: None

Props: reader's scripts (optional)
